

In pursuance of the authorization given by the Board of Finance dated 6.2.2014 duly approved by the Syndicate/ Senate dated 22.2.2014 & 22.3.2014 respectively, the Vice Chancellor has approved to adopt the Central Government Notification No. **1/4/2021-EII (B) dated 25.10.2021** w.r.t. increase in Dearness allowance from existing 28% to 31% w.e.f. 1.7.2021 for employees drawing pay in 7th CPC (Copy enclosed).

The enhanced Dearness allowance rate of 31% shall be added in pay bills of November, 2021 (payable in December, 2021) of all those employees who are drawing salaries as per 7th CPC and accordingly the payment of arrears of enhanced Dearness allowance for the period from 1.7.2021 to 31.10.2021 be released.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revision of Rate of Dearness Allowance (DA) to Central Government Employees due from 01.07.2021

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 1/1/2020-E-II (B) dated 20th July, 2021 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance payable to Central Government employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 28% to 31% of the Basic Pay with effect from 1st July, 2021.

2. The term 'Basic Pay' in the revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribed Level in the Pay Matrix as per 7th CPC recommendations accepted by the Government, but does not include any other type of pay like special pay, etc.

3. The Dearness Allowance will continue to be a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay within the ambit of FR 9(21).

4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above may be rounded to the next higher rupee and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

5. These orders shall also apply to the civilian employees paid from the Defence Services Estimates and the expenditure will be chargeable to the relevant head of the Defence Services Estimates. In respect of Armed Forces personnel and Railway employees, separate orders will be issued by the Ministry of Defence and Ministry of Railways, respectively.

6. In their application to the persons belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders are issued under Article 148(5) of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
