Circular

Sir/Madam,

This is in supersession to circular No. 7112-7311/FDO dated 28.11.2023.

In pursuance to the decision of the Board of Finance dated 04.10.2023 and Syndicate dated 28.10.2023, the Vice Chancellor, in anticipation of approval of the Senate, is pleased to revise the pay of contractual/temporary Teaching/Non-Teaching employees, as under:

1. The Contractual/Temporary teachers who were appointed before 17.07.2020 & drawing initial of the pay band and grade pay along with prescribed allowances (wherever applicable) be allowed revised consolidated emoluments to be calculated on the basis of initial of their corresponding pay level in the revised pay scales along with prescribed allowances, as applicable.
2. The non-teaching employees who have been appointed before 17.07.2020 and are drawing initial of the pay their respective pay band and grade pay in unrevised scales (including prescribed allowance as applicable) be allowed revised pay as per the following formula as notified by the Chandigarh Administration vide No. 27/284-IH(7)-2023/658 dated 18.01.2023:-

Initial pay [Existing basis pay+113% DA=Amount+15% rounded off nearest to Rs. 100/-]+NPA (wherever applicable)+ DA (as revised from time to time)

3. The revised pay as recommended above shall be applicable from 01.10.2021 in terms of the notification of U.T., Administration, Chandigarh vide No. 27/284-IH(7)-2023/658 dated 18.01.2023.
